

10 SIMPLE GUIDELINES FOR YOU AS A GUEST; WE CALL IT «VOSSAVET»

FIRSTLY - WATCH OUT FOR CRAZY LOCALS - FLYING IN THE SKY OR PADDLING IN THE RIVER

2 RESPECT OUR ANIMALS AND BIRDS

Keep dogs on a leash and ensure that gates are closed.



3 YOU MIGHT SPOT A REINDEER, DO NOT DISTURB

Reindeer are easily disturbed by human activity. Retreat if you spot them or if any observations have been done. There are plenty of other places to hike.

4 FOLLOW THE PATHS

Leave no trace such as cairns, campfire remains, tent pegs etc. Memories belong to your camera!

5 USE ESTABLISHED CAMPING SITES

If not, put up your tent at least 150 metres from occupied houses or cabins. Respect the locals when you park your car.

6 BRING YOUR TRASH BACK FROM YOUR HIKE

And if someone else forgot, we would be thankful for your help. Recycle where possible. Avoid wet wipes when nature calls as they decompose slowly.

7 GENERAL CAMPFIRE BAN FROM 15 APRIL - 15 SEPTEMBER

During summer, open fire (including disposable grill) are forbidden in or near forests and other outlying areas. Always consider the risk of forest fire.

8 MOTHER NATURE CAN BE UNPREDICTABLE

Our mountains are beautiful all year long. However, mountain weather is subject to rapid changes and extreme conditions. For unexperienced hikers we recommend you hire a local guide.

9 BRING SUSTAINABILITY IN YOUR BACKPACK

Together we can make a difference. Ask for local food and drinks. Did you deposit your bottle? Can you bike or take the bus/train instead of your car?
